### APPLICANTS WHOSE FIRST LANGUAGE IS NOT ENGLISH

Applicants whose first language is not English must demonstrate English language proficiency prior to admission. Please see [uvic.ca/enpr](https://uvic.ca/enpr) for complete information on how you can satisfy the English Language Proficiency Requirement, including:

- A minimum score of iBT 90 or higher on the TOEFL exam, with no section less than 20
- A minimum score of 6.5 or higher on the Academic IELTS exam, with no section less than 6.0
- A passing score (80%) on the English Language Centre's University Admission Preparation (UAP) program

### WORKING IN CANADA

You may work on or off campus while completing your full-time degree studies at UVic. Also, if you have successfully completed your degree at UVic, you may apply for a post-graduation work permit (PGWP).
